The ASMC Safety Awards aim to encourage participation in good safety practice and risk management.

Awards are open to all employees of Sugar Mills and Sugar Cane Farms, nominations should be submitted through your Line Manager and Safety Manager, **nominations close 24 November 2017**. The awards and the assessment criteria are:

Best Solution to a Specific Workplace Health and Safety Issue

The ASMC would like to recognise an individual or a team which has found an innovative and valuable business solution to a workplace risk or hazard. The application may come from Cane Farming operations, Sugar Milling or Cane Supply and Transport. The solution may or may not be as a result of capital expenditure to solve the problem given that innovation can be a new work practice.

Transferability of entry - Can this initiative be applied across other industries and workplaces?

Innovation - To what extent is this initiative innovative, creative, new and different?

Risk Control - How does the initiative apply the hierarchy of control? (Elimination, substitution, engineering, isolation, administrative controls).

Risk Profile - What difference would the initiative make to the risk profile of a workplace as a whole?

Commitment - What commitment is evident in the initiative? Details of resources invested in developing the solution (human and financial) and in ensuring it was successfully integrated into the business.

Consultation - Was consultation built into the implementation/on-going monitoring of the initiative?

Evaluation - How effective is the initiative? Evidence of injury and risk reduction.

Health and Safety Champion of the Year

In granting this award the ASMC would like to recognise a manager or an employee who is a champion of Health & Safety and works to improve safety performance within the workplace. The intention is to recognise and reward employees for how they engage managers and work mates in identifying and managing risk to employees, suppliers and the general community. The application may come from Cane Farming operations, Sugar Milling or Cane Supply and Transport.

Commitment - Has the nominee demonstrated commitment to workplace health and safety?

Representation - Is there evidence the nominee has fulfilled their powers and function under the Act?

Functions - Is there evidence the nominee has fulfilled their powers and function under the Act?

Achievements - Are the achievements outstanding considering the barriers faced?

Excellence in safety Training and or Communication

The ASMC would like to recognise organisations who have effectively and innovatively communicated a Workplace Health Safety message to their workforce. The communication of a message can be a one-off event or an ongoing program. Or an innovative Workplace Health Safety training program that has been implemented. The training program can be one-off or ongoing.

Achievement - Has the achievement lead to a significant improvement in health and safety?

Needs Assessment - How does the program meet the needs of workers and the workplace?

Transferability - Can the achievement / improvement be utilised in other workplaces?

Perseverance - Is the achievement outstanding considering any barriers faced?

Evaluation - Is the achievement a sustainable health and safety outcome?
