

Sugar Mills as a Source of Renewable Power

27% of Queensland's and 2% of Australia's renewable energy is generated by sugar mills. This amounts to over 1 million megawatt hours (MWh) of co-generated electricity per year, which would otherwise result 1.5 million tonnes of greenhouse gases from non-renewable sources.
